



What is an ERP System?

- Enterprise = whole organization, across departmental
- Resources = People + Money + Stuff + Services + Assets
- Planning = one set of Data → Reporting → Decisions
- Benefits
 - Automation of business processes
 - Data sharing
 - Information in real-time
 - Eliminate redundancies

Risk Factors - Failed Implementation

Requirement to change policies, processes

Disruption to existing transactions and services

Learning curve for employees transitioning from one system to another system

Resistance to change



Mono County Challenges


- Lack of time reporting by activity or project
 - i.e. manual compilation of hours and costing for disaster events and grant awards
- Redundancy via multiple applications that do not interface with the ERP System
- No integration of data (data migration)
 - Duplication of efforts to recreate data in multiple systems
 - Management reporting deficiencies
- Training employees to use multiple systems
- Current ERP no longer supported
- Vulnerable server

- Needs Assessment Process Analysis

 - Process mapping (Status Quo vs To-Be Vision = GAP)


